Subject:	Medical Education Programs

Thank you for the opportunity to share information related to the continuing medical education programs offered by the Integrative Health Forum on behalf of medical professionals worldwide.

My name is Sharon M. Weinstein, and I am a registered nurse, health educator and founder of the Integrative Health Forum (<u>www.ihfglobal.com</u>) and director of the Energy Medicine continuing medical education series. Allow me to share some information related to the Forum and the implications of having subjects such as EMF sensitivity lectured in the academic environment.

Integrative health forum

The Integrative Health Forum evolved in 2003 as the result of the work of 13 charter members with a vision of creating the evidence-base for wellness practice. The group has grown significantly as a result of weekly calls, breakfast seminars, and more. In 2008, the European Health Forum was created to address the needs of wellness specialists in the European community. Together, as IHFglobal, we can extend our message to the masses – worldwide. Our goal is to become a recognized international leader for wellness and health, and the resource for health-related issues.

In 2008, the Energy Medicine continuing medical education came to life in Chicago. Under the direction of chief education officer, Sharon Weinstein, the template for a program that would attract licensed healthcare professionals as well as lay professions was created. Applications were made, and alliances created with the American Academy of Family Practice, the American Holistic Nurses Association, the National Certification Board for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork, the National Certification Commission on Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) and CEBroker representing all professional boards for the State of Florida to ensure approval for the educational model and content.

This is the only program of its kind in which the concepts of cellular energy and the function of the human body are integrated with the growing focus on the dangers of WiFi and cellular technology. These programs are not commercial; they have been approved for continuing medical education by boards across North America and they offer credentials to the clinicians involved in the sessions. We want to present this information to the medical community, to governments, to school boards, and to the general public. This is our mantra...and we are determined to educate the masses to protect our children.
